Over the past year and a half Peter and I have had the great pleasure of working for the Lord Howe Island Board as their consultant town planners. We have loved our trips to the island during this time and hope you enjoy our short feature on this special World Heritage Listed place. Lord Howe Island (LHI) is located 600km N/E Sydney and directly east of Port Macquarie.

LHI is surrounded by a beautiful coral reef and contains abundant marine and bird life. To get around most people either walk or ride a bike. LHI is unique in that the visitor numbers are set at a maximum of 400 at any one time. Furthermore, only 25 new dwellings are currently permitted until the year 2025.

Mt Gower on Lord Howe Island has just been listed as one of the top 5 walks in the world by NineMSN.

In the News

Major Planning Review by NSW Government Alexandra Smith from SMH wrote on July 13, 2011: THE state's planning laws will be overhauled following a major review of the system to be overseen by the Land and Environment Court commissioner, Tim Moore and former state minister, Ron Dyer.

Planning Minister, Brad Hazzard, said it would be the biggest overhaul of the system in more than 30 years and would "kick-start an era of integrity and transparency". Hazzard said businesses which had fled NSW needed to be given the confidence to return to the state.

The review would start with a four-month "listening and scoping stage", followed by a green paper on the options for the new planning system and then a white paper which would include the new legislation.

AAP will keep you informed through our newsletter of significant recommended changes to the current NSW planning system as this review progresses.

These policies on coal and gas mining will have interesting implications for affected landowners and local communities.
